### **When you go online to make appointments you will need:**

Your own name

Your child's first name and legal surname. Preferred names will not be recognised.

Your child's date of birth

You can book for Parents' Evening from **today until 12 noon on Wednesday 22 February 2017**.

### **Troubleshooting Tips - Please read before Booking!**

The child's date of birth has to be entered in exactly the right format eg using four digits for the year of birth - 12/06/2002

You must enter your exact details e.g. if you are known as Ms, Mrs would not be recognised.

The email address you enter is only to get a confirmation of your appointment.

If you are unable to book at home or online, please call the general office and speak to Mrs Vingoe (01872 245133) or by email on [mvingoe@penair.cornwall.sch.uk](mailto:mvingoe@penair.cornwall.sch.uk) who will be able to assist you in making your booking.
