

Improving homework behaviours

We consider homework to be an important part of the learning cycle, supporting students with preparing for, consolidating and extending their learning. Where students fail to submit a homework or it is late, we view this as showing poor commitment to learning; a behaviour that can be changed.

Should a student not meet this commitment to learning, this will be dealt with by the class teacher in the first instance and then escalated through Head of Faculty to the Academic Leads for each Key Stage (Y7 & Y8: Mrs Logan or Y9, Y10 & Y11: Mrs Miller). The sanction set is designed to enable the students to reflect on their learning behaviour and complete the homework rather than to serve as a detention. A lack of commitment to learning will be logged on Classcharts.

In the event a student fails to attend a homework reflection session, this will be escalated to a detention.
